If you have any questions at any stage please speak to the Leaders of your Section or me.



FINANCIAL

Scouting being fundamentally an outdoors based program there will, from time to time, be Unit or Patrol Activities, camps, hikes etc., which are an integral part of the Scouting program.

- ⇒ Once off joining fee \$100 includes section shirt, first set of badges, group scarf and woggle and Scouts Sa Affiliation Fee
- ⇒ Not included in the joining term (But every term Afterwards) \$80 per term (Invoiced at start of every term—Due week Four)
 - ⇒ Extra costs may include—Camps, Sleepovers, any out of hall activities the youth decide which require payment
- ⇒ Replacement Scouting Uniform badges, woggles or scarfs can be purchased from the Scout Group where needed.

But you can be sure that we carefully aim to keep the price of such activities to a minimum.

If there are any extenuating circumstances that prevent you from payment on your invoice on time, then please contact the Group Leader.
