Patrol Points System

Throughout each term, Scouts are able to earn points for their patrol. An award is given to the patrol with the most points at the end of the term. The points reset each term, however the patrol with the most points across all four terms also receives an award at the end of the year. The Patrol Points System is designed to encourage teamwork and responsibility in Scouts.

Special Interest Area Badge	+ 25 Points	Personal First Aid Kit Inspection – Item Missing	- 1 Point
Milestone Badge	+ 25 Points	Weekend Event Participation	+ 10 Points
Australian Scout Award Activity <small>Adventurous Journey, Personal Development or Leadership Course, Personal Reflection</small>	+ 40 Points	Not in uniform <small>Invested but missing shirt, neckie, woggle and/or all awarded badges</small>	- 1 Point
Australian Scout Award	+ 50 Points	Dice Roll – complete an activity	+ 1 Point

Points may be added or subtracted at the discretion of Leaders for the behaviour of Scouts.
