What is OneCamp?

OneCamp will bring together everyone from Joey Scouts to Rover Scouts to discover new interests and opportunities for personal growth. Meet new friends and tackle adventurous, fun, challenging and inclusive activities.

All participants from Joey Scouts to Rover Scouts will camp together in OneCamp Units, supported by adult Leaders. OneCamp Units will camp together, eat together, tackle activities together, and support wellbeing together. OneCamp Units will be grouped together to form OneCamp Villages.

It is expected between 1,700 and 2,200 people will take part in OneCamp.

Attending OneCamp from Interstate

OneCamp 2026 has been endorsed by Scouts Australia and is open to all Scouts around Australia.

There are no State contingents for OneCamp 2026. Interstate participants will need to organise their own travel to and from Perth. Transfers between Perth Airport and the event campsite are included in the event fees.

Interstate participants will be accommodated within a OneCamp Unit.

OneCamp organisers can also put in you contact with other participants from SA.

The Program

OnceCamp will feature nine epic on-site activity zones, evening entertainment for all ages and fullday adventure activities held off-site.

Multi-day expeditions are available for Venturer and Rover Scouts.

Cost

Event fees vary for different age sections to reflect the varying length of stay for each age section.

- Joey Scouts: \$375Cub Scouts: \$595Scouts: \$995
- Venturer Scouts: \$625* (additional fees apply for chosen expedition)

The fees for interstate participants are the same as those for Western Australian participants.

What's Included

- Event program, including all activities and evening entertainment.
- All accommodation costs.
- Transport to and from offsite activities.
- Transport to and from the event, including travel to and from Swan Valley for regional participants.
- All meals for the duration of OneCamp 2026.
- A merchandise pack including a badge and shirt.

Applications

Interstate participants are invited to apply directly to the OneCamp 2026 online application system via onecamp.com.au.

Your application will be passed to the SA State Branch for review and approval. Once all fees are paid, your application will then be reviewed by the OneCamp Event Team for approval.

Applications close at midnight on 30 November 2025 (AWST).
