The Reynella Scout Group Term Fee covers the ongoing facilitation of Scouting within the Scout Group.

But what does this fee cover?

We believe the Reynella Scout Group offers value for money.



Term Fee:



In 2023 the Reynella Scout Group Term Fee was \$105. However, to keep up with our increasing expenses, our term fees must increase in 2024.

We will consult with families on this increase; with member families asked to vote on a preferred fee structure moving forward. A new Term Fee will be set as a result of this consultation.

Scouts SA Branch Membership Fee (\$165 annually)

The Scout Group on pays this amount to Scouts SA Head Office for each member (youth and adult) annually. This fee covers; members support services, safety in Scouting, IT services, marketing, etc..

If comparing Scout Groups, please note some Groups will invoice their members separately for the Scouts SA Membership Fee whilst others (including us) collect the funds for it as part of their Term Fee.

Leader Expenses – Training, Membership, Uniform

The Scout Group covers the cost of Leader training, membership and uniform so volunteers are not left out of pocket. (All Leaders within Scouts Australia are required to complete training to ensure we continue to provide the highest quality activities for our youth members.)

Hall Rental Fees and Maintenance (\$223 a quarter)

The Scout Group leases the Hall through the City of Onkaparinga. The Scout Group has a maintenance lease, this means we pay the council to maintain the property and its safety.

Insurance (\$513 a quarter)

This includes; activity, property and contents insurance.

Award Program Badges

The Scout Group provides programs which enable youth members to achieve through the Youth Program. The Scout Group provides the badges youth earn without further charge.

Utilities Services – Electricity (approx. \$300 a quarter), Water (approx. \$120 a quarter), Internet (\$215 a quarter), Hall Cleaning (\$730 a quarter)

The Scouts Group pays for its utility services. The Scout Group pays a cleaner to keep the Scout Hall clean and tidy, providing a hygienically safe environment for our members.

Activity Resources and Upkeeps

Textas, paint, soccer balls, cooking flour, gas cylinders, tents, trailer etc. are all bought by the Scout Group. Many of these items also have ongoing upkeep costs (vehicle registrations, electrical tagging and testing, etc.).

Note - Facility Improvements are not financed through
Term Fee payments. Facility improvements are financed
through grant programs and/or fundraising.
